- > Given as an assessment to test the understanding of the students
- Reinforcement of the concepts and lessons learned during the day
- Given as a preparation for a new lesson to be taught

Benefits of Homework

Immediate effects on achievement and learning include:

- Better retention of factual knowledge
- Increased understanding
- Better critical thinking and concept formation
- Better information processing
- > Regular revision and practice

Types of Homework

- Preparation of presentation in any subject
- Reading on various materials
- Research on a particular topic
- > Interviews family members, etc
- Observation-weather, experiments
- Written work
- Preparation for spelling
- Organisation of notes
- Project work (group work after school)
- E-learning
