

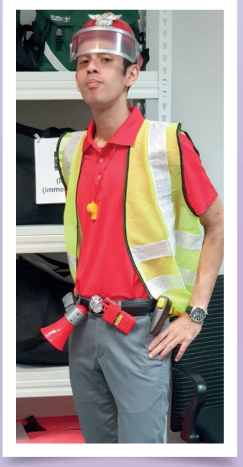
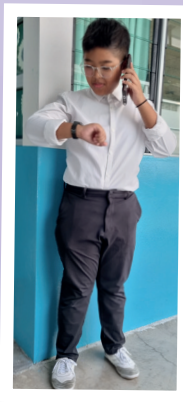
# Aspirations on Children's Day
