Smoothening the transition to Primary 1

1. Transition is the process in which a child moves into a new environment

2. When moving from pre-school to primary, a child will have to adapt to unfamiliar setting and routines

When your child has transited well, he/she will:

- Feel safe and comfortable in the new environment
- Be able to manage daily challenges
- Be able reach out to teachers and/ or peers for support when needed





- Handover of child to family member/ helper
- Be punctual
- Child will remain at the waiting area within the school compound with the teacher
- Please come nearer to the gate once your child's group is called out.

School Bus, External Student Care & Big Heart Student Care Centre @ WRPS

- Teacher will lead your child to the basketball court
- Child will sit at a designated spot


9. Dismissal Arrangement:




