
Learning Dispositions	Examples of Behavioural Traits to be Exhibited:

- Pocket money









## Dismissal at Gates 2/3/4

- Main Teacher stationed at Gates 2, 3 & 4
- Call out group by group (Groups 1-7)
- Handover of child to family member/ helper
- Be punctual
- Child will remain at the waiting area within the school compound with the teacher

# Taking the School Bus

- Teacher will lead your child to the basketball court
- Child will sit at a designated spot


#### **External Student Care**

- Teacher will lead your child to the foyer
- If there is a bus transport, the driver will pick up your child.

- Teacher will lead your child to the canteen
- Designated space for them to sit at the canteen

- SCC Teacher will take over




#### **Tour Around the School**


