No.	Learning Dispositions	Some Examples of Behavioural Traits to be Exhibited:
1	Perseverance [Children will keep working at a task without giving up]	 I learn from mistakes I do not give up I try different ways to overcome challenges I ask clarifying questions
2	Engagement [Children will immerse in what they are doing and enjoy what they do]	 I enjoy doing my classwork and homework I complete my work on time I give my attention during lessons I give my best when I do my work
3	Curiosity [Children will show interest in things that are happening around them]	 I listen attentively when others are speaking I ask questions to find out more about a topic I show interest and explore about what I observe
4	Teamwork [Children will learn to work together to achieve a common goal]	 I share my ideas with others I work well with others on tasks I respect the views and ideas of others
